Hold a 'dress yellow' day at your school or workplace, or even run a yellow-themed dress-up competition online. Ask those taking part for a donation.



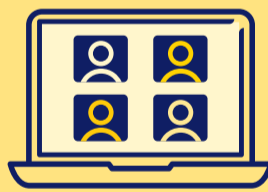
## Gifts that give back
